GENERAL CONTEST INFO:

- **AAU BATON RULES:** The AAU Baton Twirling Rulebook is available at www.aaubaton.org. AAU Membership must be obtained PRIOR to submitting entry. (Membership is not instant so please allow several days to process.)
- **PROGRAM, PROCESSING FEE, CEDAR POINT PASS:** There will be a \$35 fee per athlete. **All solo and team participants** must pay this fee with their solo or team entry form. Each athlete will receive a 5-day pass to Cedar Point.
- **PAYMENT:** PayPal must be used when submitting the [online entry form](#).
- **REFUNDS:**
**No refunds on entry fees or credits to other competitions will be given.
- **CHANGES TO ENTRIES:** The contest director reserves the right to make any changes deemed necessary. No changes by contestants may be made once an entry is received. **ONLY errors made by the contest director will be corrected the day of the contest. NO LATE ENTRIES.**
- **FOOD:** A concession stand will be provided during the day. No outside food allowed.
- **MUSIC:** All team and solo events that require music must email an **MP3 file** to remykyes@gmail.com by the May 5 entry deadline. Music will be played on a laptop through the sound system at the contest. Team directors and solo contestants should also bring back-up copies for your music to the contest.

AAU Team Events Offered:

Twirling Team, Dance-Twirl Team, Novelty Twirl Team, Street Parade Team, Show Twirl Team, Auxiliary Majorette Line, College Majorette Line, Twirling Corps, & Parade Corps.

Open Team Events: (These teams do not qualify for AAU Junior Olympics)
Dance-Twirl Team and Novelty Twirl Team for Elementary, Middle, High School, and Collegiate.

Team Sizes for Twirling Team, Dance-Twirl Team, Novelty Twirl Team, Auxiliary Majorette Line:

Extra-Small (2-3), Small (4-9),

Large (10-19), Extra-Large (20+)

Team Sizes for Corps: Small (10-14), Large (15-19), Extra Large (20+)

Team Sizes for All Other Events: Small (4- 9), Large (10-19), Extra-Large (20+)

Cost: \$20 extra small; \$35 small; \$45 large; \$55 extra large

SOLO EVENTS

Age Divisions, Levels, & Requirements for

Baton Solo Events: Age Divisions are 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16-18, 19-22, 23+. See AAU Baton Twirling Rulebook.

Solo Events Offered:

Basic Strut, Military Strut, Parade Strut, X-Strut, Straight-Line Strut, One-Baton, Two-Baton, Three-Baton, Multiple Baton, Flag, Dance Twirl Solo, Novelty Solo, Collegiate Half-Time, Collegiate Downfield

SOLO CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS

NOTE: These Championship Events are NOT qualifying events for the AAU Junior Olympic Games. These are Title Events for the Cedar Point Regional Only.

EVENTS & REQUIREMENTS:

- ◆ **Cedar Point Regional Twirling All-Star:**
X-Strut, One-Baton Solo and Two-Baton Solo
 - Solo One-Baton determines competition level
 - Levels Offered: Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced
- ◆ **Cedar Point Regional Parade Majorette:**
Perform Basic, Military Strut, and Parade Strut (Basic score is used to break tie.)
 - **Levels offered: Novice & Beginner Only**
- ◆ **Open Elementary, Middle, High, Collegiate Champion:** Perform a one-baton solo.
 - 2023-2024 school year grade determines division
 - Levels offered:
 - Elementary: Grade 1-5
 - Middle: Grades 6-8
 - High: Grades 9-12
 - Collegiate

NOTE: Twirlers do not have to twirl for their school line to compete in these divisions.

OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS

- ◆ **OPEN Cedar Point Champion Twirler**
 - One level
 - Twirl-off of all age division winners to determine the Top Twirler at The Point
- ◆ **OPEN Cedar Point Champion Strutter**
 - **One level**
 - **Strut-off of all age division winners to determine the Top Strutter at The Point**

AAU ALL-AROUND BATON CHAMPIONSHIP EVENT

If you wish to enter the AAU All-Around

Championship event at the 2024 AAU Junior Olympic Games competition, you must enter **ALL** of the events required for your division (refer to Rulebook for the list of required events). A bid to compete in the AAU Junior Olympics will be awarded to all who have entered the required categories for their Championship level.

AWARDS

All Events:

- Medals for Individual Events
- Results will be posted for each event

Championship Events:

- Plaque for 1st place
- Plaques for 2nd and 3rd place

PLACEMENTS & QUALIFICATIONS:

Solo Events: Medals for 1st – 3rd Place
(Top 10 qualify for AAU Junior Olympics)

Team Events: Medals for 1st – 3rd Place
(Top 6 for each event qualify for AAU Junior Olympics)
