Description of Events

Novice Basic Skills

Contestants compete in modeling (**no interview**) in costume 20%, basic strut 40%, and solo 40%. Solo determines ability level, and this event is only open to novice twirlers.

Beginner/Intermediate Pageant of Alabama

Open only to Alabama residents. Solo status determines Beg. or Int. division. 20%, modeling in costume w/ interview, 40% x-strut and 40% solo. First place winners in Beg. and Int. pageant advance to Nationals.

Miss Majorette of Alabama

Open only to Alabama residents in the Advanced division. Solo status determines eligibility. 20% modeling in dress with interview, 40% strut, 40% solo. Top three Advanced winners in each age division will advance to Nationals.

Special Novice Solo

Open to all who have never won a first in any solo event, regardless of affiliation. Win does not count towards advancement.

Rating Lane Note:

This is not a competitive lane. All NBTA rules apply. Must be entered in the corresponding pageant or open event.
