# EVENT DESCRIPTIONS

**X-Strut:** X-Formation, no releases, NO gymnastics

Fancy Strut: Releases allowed, gymnastics allowed, straight line or any floor pattern allowed

Freestyle/Rhythmic: Use 1 baton only, no props, provide own music, no trick restrictions

Miss Springtime Mini Pageant: Modeling & Interview

Miss Sweet Pea (Special Novice 0-6, 7-9, 10-12): Modeling (no interview), Basic Strut, & Presentation

Miss Buttercup (Novice 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16+): Modeling (no interview), Basic Strut, & Solo

Miss Daisy (Beginner 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16+): Modeling, Solo, & X-Strut or Fancy Strut

Miss Sunflower (Intermediate 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16+): Modeling, Solo, & X-Strut or Fancy Strut

Miss Yellow Rose (Advanced 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16+): Modeling, Solo, & X-Strut or Fancy Strut

Miss Magnolia (College Pageant): Modeling, Solo, & X-Strut

Freestyle/Rythmic

**Intermediate** – 1-3 spin max, no aerial gymnastics, only 1 double element trick allowed (i.e. double illusion, double leap, etc.), only partial monster roll

Advanced – no restrictions, gymnastics allowed

Title Events: Only allowed to enter *one* level.

Each winner will receive a custom sash, tiara, and gift to be presented during awards ceremony.

\*SPRINGTIME FESTIVAL CHAMPION: Solo only for 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16+ - Top 3 will be selected from each category to compete in Festival Finals for the Champion to be selected!

\*Title events separate from "regular" individual competition.

\*Title events subject to combining levels, if necessary, based on number of entries and at discretion of contest

#### SCHOLARSHIPS/AWARDS

# **Tuition-Based & Young-Artist Intensive Scholarships**

- Tuition-Based scholarship awards are VM Springtime Festival Based Scholarships. Recipients of this award are invited to return to next season's competition on a full tuition, half tuition, or quarter tuition-based scholarships to be applied towards dancers' or twirlers' entry fees at the 2025 VM Springtime Festival.
- Young-Artist Intensive Based Scholarships winners will receive full tuition, half tuition, or quarter tuition scholarships to be applied towards dancers' or twirlers' attendance at VM Young-Artist Intensive June 2024.
- O How to win: In a spirit of recognition and celebration, each judge will have the opportunity of awarding tuition based & young artist intensive scholarships to standout athletes throughout the day. It's a day where outstanding dedication and skill meet deserving acknowledgment, paving the way for a promising future in dance and baton twirling.

#### **Inspiring Attitude Award**

This award will go to a competitor who displayed exemplary sportsmanship on and off the floor, proving a sense of community and support among their competitors. The Inspiring Attitude Award winner will receive \$100 VMCash to be applied towards dancers' or twirlers' entry fees at the 2025 VM Springtime Festival.

# **Studio Squad Award**

This award will go to the studio who brought in the most students.

# **Springtime Festival Champion:**

 One \$50 VMCash Scholarship will be awarded to Springtime Festival Champion in each age division. VMCash is to be applied towards twirlers' entry fees at the 2025 VM Springtime Festival.

#### **RULES/REGULATIONS**

- o Concessions available and benefitting 2023-2024 NJHS/NHS Twirlers.
- No refunds for any reason (other than cancellation of entire event). Postponement due to weather is NOT a cancellation.
- o Team entries must be submitted altogether, by coach, with one payment.
- Neither contest directors nor contest facilities will be held responsible for accidents, injuries, or loss of property.
- o Program will be emailed to coaches one week prior and athletes one day prior. Please print program.
- o Contestants compete at the age they will be on September 1, 2023.
- Set system will be utilized for all events, except modeling. See program for set and lane per event entered.
- The main goal is the development and promotion of *Good Sportsmanship*. Therefore, unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated.
- o Group/Freestyle comments will be provided via digital recording and emailed (or scoresheets).
- o Music for groups/freestyles must be emailed to <a href="mailto:kayli@vickimichelle.net">kayli@vickimichelle.net</a> by February 1<sup>st</sup>. Bring a digital backup (failure to have one will result in a scratch if there is a music glitch).
- o Team/corp age division is determined by averaging age of members.
- Athlete may be a member of more than one team/corp, but team must be in separate categories. Athlete cannot compete against self.
- If a team/corp member cannot perform on contest day and it changes category entered, team may perform for evaluation only.
- o SMOKING PROHIBITED anywhere on school property and at competitions.
- o A 1<sup>st</sup> place win is a "win" with more than one athlete in each category, except for a protected win.
- o **Novice** contestant will be a novice contestant until receiving (5) first-place novice wins.
- o **Beginner** contestant will be a beginner contestant until receiving (5) first-place beginner wins.
- o **Intermediate** contestant will be an intermediate contestant until receiving (8) first-place intermediate wins.
- o **Advanced** contestant has reached the highest and most prestigious competitive level.
- o Athlete/group may enter one level above current classification/proficiency level.
- All other twirling organizations 1<sup>st</sup> place wins are recognized, except USTA Strut.
- o Contest Directors have the right to combine/divide age groups as entries warrant.
- o Age groups and awards may vary slightly at discretion of Contest Directors.
- o \$20.00 fee for late entries.
- o \$30.00 NSF fee for returned checks.
- FREE ADMISSION FOR SPECTATORS.
