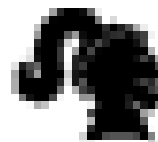

General Information:

- All contestants must wear tennis shoes or other non-marking soled shoes on the gym floor
- Food and beverages will be provided by the Silver Knights Parent Organization throughout the day, including multiple lunch options (walking tacos, hot dogs, pulled pork sandwiches, and more).
- Contest directors, staff, and Orland Hills Recreation Center are not responsible for lost/stolen/damaged property, accidents, illnesses, or injury during the competition
- There will be ample practice space available
- There will also be room for setting up "pop-up" tents for changing
- Entries must be submitted via online entry only. No fax, email, phone or snail mail entries accepted.

- Payment must be submitted at the time of the entry via Venmo (be sure to include contestant's name, phone number, and Chicagoland in the "What's for" section. If paying by check then the check must be received within 5 days. Entries will not be processed until payment is received.
- Contestant fee of \$20 must be paid by all contestants (waived for siblings after the first contestant fee paid; also waived if doing park district events only)
- Any advancements in level must be reported within 24 hours of advancement
- No late entries allowed for X-struts or pageants due to the use of a set system for those events
 - Late entry fee of \$5 per event must be included in any entries submitted after 5/30/25
- No changes will be made the day of the competition
- No refunds/credits
- Age divisions: 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16+ (age as of 9/1/24)
- Order of events: Modeling, Strut (basic then X-strut), Solo routines with own music, Solo events, Twirl off, Awards
 - Team/Corps event timing will be determined based on number of entries
- Awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for all open events
 - Award winners have the option of choosing an award or saving up points to redeem for rhinestone TWIRLER pins or gift cards (Amazon, Bath & Body Works, Starbucks, Target, Ulta). Points may be carried over from contest to contest if desired to "save up" for a desired prize.
- Awards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place for title modeling and pageant events with banner as well to the first place winner
- Additional awards may be added as division sizes warrant

CONTEST EVENTS

- Teams (see separate entry form)-->dance twirl, twirl team, halftime team, High School teams, danceline teams
- Corps (see separate entry form)

NBTA Sanctioned Individual Events:

- Miss Chicago (4 awards)-->Modeling in costume with an interview. Special award and banner presented to winner. Beginners are eligible to enter this event, but also must enter Beginner Modeling.
- Miss Chicagoland (4 awards)-->3 part pageant (modeling, strut, solo). Special award and banner presented to winner. Modeling in costume (Adv may opt to model in dress) with an interview.
- Novice Miss Chicagoland (4 awards)-->3 part pageant (modeling, strut, solo). Special award and banner presented to winner. Modeling is in costume with NO interview. Strut is basic strut. Park district twirlers are encouraged to enter.
- Modeling-->Pri, Nov, Beg, Adv. Modeling is in costume with NO interview
- Dress modeling-->one level, with an interview
- Basic Strut-->Pri, Nov, Beg, Adv
- X-Strut-->Pri, Nov, Beg, Int, Adv (will be done as part of a set system)
- Solo-->Pri, Nov, Beg, Int, Adv (Adv winners will qualify for twirl off)
- Instate/Visitors Solo-->Pri, Nov, Beg, Int, Adv
- 2-Baton-->Nov, Beg, Int, Adv
- 3-Baton-->Beg, Adv
- Duets-->Beg, Adv (combined ages 0-18, 19-24, 25-30, 31+); entry to be sent in by one member only
- Trios-->division as warrant; average of combined aged; entry to be sent in by one member only
- Boys events-->as needed
- College Majorette Solo-->Miss Majorette of America pageant solo on regular lanes
- Solo with Music-->High School & College levels offered; music must be uploaded with entry at time of entry (file saved with name and event)
- Rhythmic Twirl-->Adv; music must be uploaded with entry at time of entry (file saved with name and event)
- Show Twirl-->one level; music must be uploaded with entry at time of entry (file saved with name and event)
- Down the Field-->Junior High, High School, College
- Rating Lane-->offered for modeling; must also enter your own level of same open event

Park District Events:

- Trick List
- Primary Parade Routine

Non-NBTA Sanctioned Individual Events:

- Recorded Feedback Rating Lane-->X-strut & Solo
 - You will hand the judge/clerk your phone and they will make live comments while your routine is recorded on your phone so that you can review your commentary at any time. Judge will also provide verbal feedback upon completion of your routine
 - Must also enter your own level of same open event
- IBTF Qualifiers Feedback Events
 - You may enter the event you have qualified for at IBTF Worlds and will be critiqued by a judge familiar with IBTF rules
 - After your routine you will receive one-on-one feedback from the judge for up to 10 minutes regarding your performance to help you prepare for Worlds

Non-NBTA Sanctioned Fun Contest Events: These events are created to allow twirlers to have fun and relax while enjoying their favorite sport, as we know tensions rise as AYOP approaches.

- Twirling themed scavenger hunt
- Twirler dad or mom modeling
- Twirler dad or mom basic strut
- Parent/twirler duet
- Spin contest (based on solo level)
- Roll contest (based on solo level)
- Solo relay (2 to 4 twirlers will group together and put together a group solo by each girl doing a section from their solo and then switching with the next girl to do the next section until a solo is complete; judging will be done on one scoresheet)
- No drop contest
