GENERAL RULES:

- 1) Entry must be clearly printed or typed. Only one individual or group entry per form. Entries that are not legible will be returned.
- 2) Pair entry & payment must be sent on only one entry.
- 3) All entries MUST include a signed USTA Participant Waiver.
- 4) **No late entries will be accepted.** <u>All entries must be emailed by January 27, 2025.</u> Entries emailed after January 27 will not be accepted.
- 5) **Contest Surcharge**: Each athlete must include the \$20 contest surcharge with their entry. The surcharge for additional siblings in the same household is \$5. This surcharge allows there to be NO charge for admission, contest programs, or any additional facility fee.
- 6) Payment can be made via one of the following options (personal checks are not accepted):
 - Option 1: Venmo payment to @TNBatonCouncil
 - Option 2: Paypal payment follow these instructions:
 - 1. Choose "send money" to tnbatoncouncil@gmail.com
 - 2. In the notes section, include the athlete's name
 - 3. Choose "sending to a friend" (if your Paypal account is linked to your bank account, Paypal does not charge a transaction fee for sending money to a friend; if using a credit card, Paypal will charge you an additional transaction fee, typically 2.90%)
 - Option 3: Mail money order or cashier's check, payable to USTA Tennessee Baton Council, 7129 Houser Ridge Lane, Hixson, TN 37343. Payment must be received by entry deadline (January 27th).
- 7) NO REFUNDS will be given for any reason <u>other than contest cancellation</u>. If the contest is cancelled, full refunds will be given to all athletes, minus the \$20 contest surcharge.
- 8) If athlete makes a mistake on his/her entry, it *may* be corrected (when possible) up to 2 weeks prior to the contest. Errors caused by incorrect information submitted on the entry cannot be corrected the day of the competition, and the athlete/group may not be permitted to perform.
- 9) Individual and team entries must include USTA membership ID number. If you are not a USTA Member, there is a *non-member fee. USTA membership (regular & family) fees must be paid directly to USTA. See www.ustwirling.com for membership information.
 - *The non-member fee for this contest is being covered by the TN Baton Council for all non-members. We hope you enjoy this contest and consider becoming a member in the future!
- 10) AGE RULE: Athletes will compete at the age they will be on August 31, 2025.
- 11) Contest Director reserves the right to divide or combine age groups as the entries warrant.
- 12) Contest Director or host facility will not be responsible for injuries or lost/stolen items.
- 13) Contest will run on the USTA Set System.
- 14) USTA Rules and Regulations and USTA judges will be used at this event for all USTA sanctioned events.
- 15) NO SMOKING IN THE FACILITY. Basic concessions may be provided.
- 16) No flash photography is allowed at any USTA contest for the safety of the athletes.
- 17) Coaches of teams, freestyle, rhythmic twirl, short program, and collegiate event athletes will receive audio critiques from their performance via email.
- 18) Music in *MP3 format* for all groups, Freestyle, Rhythmic, Collegiate event, High School & College Championships must be submitted via email to tnbatoncouncil@gmail.com by January 27th. Please bring a CD or phone as a music backup the day of the contest.
- 19) **AWARDS**: Individual events: Trophies for 1st place, medals 2nd through 9th places.
 - Group Events: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places medals for all team members.
 - See page 4 for information & awards for the Music City Sweetheart Pageant, NashTwirl Cup Champion, High School & College Champions.
- 20) **Contest Wins:** Novice less than 3 wins in said event. Beginner less than 5 wins in said event. Intermediate won less than 10 1st place in said event. Competitive 1st places count when competing with at least one other person in an event regardless of association.
- 21) **EVENT INFORMATION:** See pages 3-6 for descriptions of each event, time limits, and a link to music.
- 22) USTA RULE FOR ENTERING MULTIPLE LEVELS: An athlete may only enter one level above their current classification/proficiency level. For instance, an athlete may only enter Novice and Beginner Two-Baton. They may NOT enter Novice, Beginner and Intermediate Two-Baton. If an athlete chooses to compete at a higher level, they are still limited to enter two consecutive classifications (for example, Beginner and Intermediate, or Intermediate and Advanced). You may not enter Beginner and Advanced. For those events in which the Intermediate level is optional (3-Baton, Artistic Twirl, Artistic Twirl Pairs and Duet), the athlete may enter both Beginner and Advanced if Intermediate is not offered as an event at that competition (IF the athlete is eligible to compete at the Beginner level in that event).

Competes In These Events

Athletes may not enter more than one pageant. Open Solo is 2.5 minute time limit to upbeat radio music.

What level are you for the Music City Sweetheart Pageant?

Below is a guide to choose the appropriate level for the pageant based on twirling skill level:

- Dolly's Sweetheart: these athletes are new to twirling, working on basic twirling skills, and are not completing more than a one spin (may be working on, but have not mastered, 2 spins).
- Opry Sweetheart: these athletes have at least one year of twirling experience, can complete basic single or double rolls (two elbows, elbow extension, etc.), and are not completing more than a two spin and single element tricks (toss illusion, toss cartwheel, etc.).
- Smoky Mountain Sweetheart: these athletes have several years of twirling experience, can complete rolls
 in continuous combinations, are completing a maximum of 3 or 4 spins, and may be working on, but are
 not consistently completing any double element tricks.
- Blue Suede Sweetheart: these athletes are consistently completing multiple roll combinations, 4+ spins, and double element tricks or higher.
- Music City Sweetheart: these athletes are consistently completing advanced/elite roll combinations, 4+ spins w/variety of catches, and competing at the elite level in their organization by placing in the top 7 at the national level.

Determining the winner:

The overall winner in each group will be determined using a place points: 1st Place = 1 points, 2nd Place = 2 points, 3rd Place = 3 points, etc. For example, an athlete placing 1st in Solo (1 points), 4th in Basic Strut (4 points), and 2nd in Costume Modeling (2 points) would have a total of 1+4+2=7 points. The athlete with the fewest place points in each division will be the Sweetheart winner. A tie in place points will be broken by combining total scores in all events.

Awards:

The overall winner of each group will receive a Music City Sweetheart Sash and custom cowgirl hat with tiara.

Other important information:

The events for the Music City Sweetheart Pageant are separate from the "regular" NashTwirl individual events. So, an entry in the MCS Pageant enters an athlete in the events listed above for their level, and ONLY athletes entered in the pageant will compete in each of those events. Athletes entered in the pageant may also choose to enter the same events in the NashTwirl competition. For example, an athlete who enters the Dolly's Sweetheart pageant will be entered in MCS Basic Strut, Open Solo & Costume Modeling; this athlete may also choose to enter the separate events of Basic Strut, Solo and/or Costume Modeling.

NASHTWARL CUP CHAMPION

Open Solo competition - the top 5 athletes in each age group will advance to NashTwirl Cup Solo finals. The winning athlete in each age group (0-9, 10-13, 14-17, 18-21, 22+) will be awarded the title of NashTwirl Cup Champion.

Awards:

Each NashTwirl Cup Champion will receive a custom NashTwirl Cup Champion denim jacket and customblinged cowboy boot award perfect for displaying at home.

*The contest director reserves the right to combine or separate age groups as warranted by the entries.

NASHTWARL CUP HIGH SCHOOL CHAMPIONSHIP

The high school twirling event is open to any individual, enrolled in high school or a member of their high school band. The athlete may use one or multiple batons to the school fight song and a musical selection of the athlete's choice. The high school twirling event should reflect the type of material utilized on the field by displaying musicality, movement across the field/competition floor, and presentation to the audience with the addition of one or multiple batons.

Awards:

The High School Champion will be awarded a Championship sash and NashTwirl Guitar (revolving award).

NASHTWARL CUP COLLEGE CHAMPIONSHIP

The college twirling event is performed by any individual, enrolled and matriculating in a college or university (undergraduate or graduate). The athlete will use one or multiple batons to the university fight song and a powerful musical selection of the athlete's choice. The collegiate twirling event should reflect the type of material utilized on the field by displaying musicality, movement across the field/competition floor, and presentation to the audience with the addition of one or multiple batons.

Awards:

The College Champion will be awarded a Championship sash and NashTwirl Guitar (revolving award)



REMINDER OF IMPORTANT USTA TEAM/GROUP RULES (full event rules can be found in the USTA Rulebook):

- Team/group athletes' ages on August 31, 2025, will be used to determine age categories (either the average age or age of oldest team member may be used).
- Important Dance Twirl Team & Twirl Team rules:
 - Dance Twirl Teams & Twirl Teams compete at the levels Novice, A, AA, AAA, and Elite.
 - Novice, A, and AA levels will be considered "open" or "Festival of the Future" level events. AAA and Elite levels will be considered "State," "Regional," or "National" level events.
 - Each level (with the exception of Elite) has content restrictions.
 - o See the <u>USTA Rulebook</u> for the full Dance Twirl Team & Twirl Team rules and content restrictions chart.
- Parade Corps, Entertainment Corps, Show Team, and Artistic Group rules:
 - o There is only one level for Parade Corps, Entertainment Corps, Show Teams, and Artistic Groups.
 - There are no age divisions for Parade Corps. Entertainment Corps have two age divisions: Primary/Juvenile (avg age 13.9 or younger) and Junior/Senior (avg age 14.0 or older).
 - Show Teams have the following age divisions: Primary, Juvenile, Junior, and Senior.
 - Member requirement for Parade Corps, Entertainment Corps, and Artistic Group is a minimum of 10 members.
