- 1) Programs will be distributed via email prior to the competition
- 2) Age for events will be calculated based on the athlete's date of birth as listed on the entry form.
- 3) The competition will run on the set system.
- 4) The competition director reserves the right to divide or combine age groups as necessary
- 5) NO REFUNDS will be given for any reason, other than the contest is cancelled.
- 6) Please abide by your organizations advancement system when entering events.
- 7) Time limits are as follows:
  - a. All Novice Open Events: 0.30 – 2.00
  - b. All modeling events: Max time 1.00
  - c. Open Solo – Max time 2.30
  - d. Open 2 Baton – 1.30 – 2.00
  - e. Open 3 Baton – 0.30 – 2.00
  - f. X Strut – the 2025 IBTF X- Strut music will be utilized
  - g. USTA Music will be utilized for all USTA Sanctioned Events
- 8) Team and Individual music must be sent electronically in mp3 or mp4 format to the contest director prior to the event. No CDs or cell phones allowed.
- 9) Spectator Admission is free.
- 10) Athletes may enter “one level up” from their current level in a particular event, including critiques. For example: Beginner solo athlete may enter Beginner and Intermediate solo.
- 11) No flash photography is allowed for the safety of the athletes.
- 12) Contest directors or the facility will not be responsible for accidents or lost/stolen items.

## Events:

### Summertime “Fun in the Sun” Championship Events:

#### Miss Summertime PAGEANT

3 part event: Modeling, Strut and Solo.

Judging: 40% strut and solo, 20% modeling.

Basic Skills athletes will do basic strut for the strutting portion of the event.

Twirling level determines division for entry

Modeling Attire: All divisions are open to wear their strut or solo costumes for modeling. Advance athletes are invited to wear a dress: Party dress for the Tiny Tot and Juvenile divisions, formal party dress for Pre-Teen, Semi Formal or formal for the Junior, Senior and Collegiate divisions. Dress is not required. Hair may be styled up or down.

### **Summertime Twirling All Around:**

3 Part Event: Solo, 2 Baton, Rhythmic/Freestyle/ShowTwirl

All events are scored equally. All music for the Freestyle/Rhythmic/ShowTwirl portion is Athlete choice.

### **Summer Time Twirl Offs:**

Beginner and Intermediate first place in the Play Baton Summertime Twirl in all age divisions will recompile for the twirl – off award at the designated level.

Advance top 2 winners in the advance Play Baton Summertime Twirl in all ages will recompile for an overall Twirling Championship Perpetual trophy.

3 Part Event: Modeling, Basic Box, and Military March (Box).
