Modeling Attire: All divisions are open to wear their strut or solo costumes for modeling. Advance athletes are invited to wear a dress: Party dress for the Tiny Tot and Juvenile divisions, formal party dress for Pre-Teen, Semi Formal or formal for the Junior, Senior and Collegiate divisions. Dress is not required. Hair may be styled up or down.

Summertime Twirling All Around:

3 Part Event: Solo, 2 Baton, Rhythmic/Freestyle/ShowTwirl

All events are scored equally. All music for the Freestyle/Rhythmic/ShowTwirl portion is Athlete choice.

Summer Time Twirl Offs:

Beginner and Intermediate first place in the Play Baton Summertime Twirl in all age divisions will recompete for the twirl – off award at the designated level.

Advance top 2 winners in the advance Play Baton Summertime Twirl in all ages will recompete for an overall Twirling Championship Perpetual trophy.
