GENERAL RULES:

- 1) Entry must be clearly printed or typed. Only one individual or group entry per form. Entries that are not legible will be returned.
- 2) Pair entry & payment must be sent on only one entry.
- 3) All entries MUST include a signed USTA Participant Waiver.
- 4) **No late entries will be accepted.** <u>All entries must be emailed by March 24, 2025.</u> Entries emailed after March 24th will be returned.
- 5) **Contest Surcharge**: Each athlete must include the \$20 contest surcharge with their entry. There is no surcharge for additional siblings in the same household. This surcharge allows there to be NO charge for admission or any additional facility fee.
- 6) Payment can be made via one of the following options (personal checks are not accepted):
 - Option 1: Venmo payment to @TNBatonCouncil
 - Option 2: Paypal payment follow these instructions:
 - 1. Choose "send money" to tnbatoncouncil@gmail.com
 - 2. In the notes section, include the athlete's name
 - 3. Choose "sending to a friend" (if your Paypal account is linked to your bank account, Paypal does not charge a transaction fee for sending money to a friend; if using a credit card, Paypal will charge you an additional transaction fee, typically 2.90%)
 - Option 3: Mail a money order order or cashier's check, payable to USTA Tennessee Baton Council, to Tri-State Championships, 7129 Houser Ridge Lane, Hixson, TN 37343.
- 7) NO REFUNDS will be given for any reason <u>other than contest cancellation</u>. If the contest is cancelled, full refunds will be given to all athletes, minus the \$20 contest surcharge.
- 8) If athlete makes a mistake on his/her entry, it *may* be corrected (when possible) up to 2 weeks prior to the contest. Errors caused by incorrect information submitted on the entry cannot be corrected the day of the competition, and the athlete/group may not be permitted to perform.
- 9) **MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:** All athletes must have a current USTA membership or pay the \$5 non-member fee to compete. USTA membership (regular & family) fees must be paid directly to USTA. See www.ustwirling.com for membership information and online membership forms.
- 10) AGE RULE: Athletes will compete at the age they will be on August 31, 2025.
- 11) **RESIDENCY RULES:** The State Championships events for AL, GA, and TN are open only to athletes residing in the respective state. Pairs/groups may enter only one State Championship (at least one athlete must reside in the state entered).
- 12) Any athlete may enter the Open Competition. The Open events are not awarded a state title.
- 13) **STATE CHAMPIONSHIP AGE DIVISIONS:** Primary: 0-9, Juvenile: 10-13, Junior: 14-17, Senior: 18-21, Adult: 22+.
 - If entries warrant, the State Championship events of Solo, Strut, Artistic Twirl, or Two Baton may be divided into the single age categories of 0-6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22+.
- 14) Age groups for the open competition will be determined by the entries for each event/level.
- 15) **State Grand Champions:** State Grand Championships will be presented for the State events of Men's Solo, Women's Solo, 2-Baton, 3-Baton, Artistic Twirl, and Strut.
- 16) Contest Director reserves the right to divide or combine age groups as the entries warrant.
- 17) Contest Director or host facility will not be responsible for injuries or lost/stolen items.
- 18) Contest will run on the USTA Set System.
- 19) USTA Rules and Regulations and USTA judges will be used at this event for all USTA sanctioned events.

- 20) NO SMOKING IN THE FACILITY.
- 21) Light concessions will be available for purchase throughout the day.
- 22) No flash photography is allowed at any USTA contest for the safety of the athletes.
- 23) Coaches of teams, freestyle, rhythmic twirl, show twirl, short program, high school event, and collegiate event athletes will receive audio critiques from their performance via email.
- 24) Music in *MP3 format* for all groups, Freestyle, Rhythmic Twirl, High School event, and Collegiate event must be submitted via email to tnbatoncouncil@gmail.com by April 12th. Please bring a backup option to play music the day of the contest.
- 25) **AWARDS:** See pages 5 & 6.
- 26) **Contest Wins:** Novice less than 3 wins in said event. Beginner less than 5 wins in said event. Intermediate won less than 10 1st place in said event. Competitive 1st places count when competing with at least one other person in an event <u>regardless of association</u>.
- 27) **EVENT INFORMATION:** See page 4 for descriptions of each event, time limits, and a link to music.
- 28) USTA RULE FOR ENTERING MULTIPLE LEVELS: An athlete may only enter one level above their current classification/proficiency level. For instance, an athlete may only enter Novice and Beginner Two-Baton. They may NOT enter Novice, Beginner and Intermediate Two-Baton. If an athlete chooses to compete at a higher level, they are still limited to enter two consecutive classifications in a particular event (for example, Beginner and Intermediate, or Intermediate and Advanced). "State" events are considered advanced level events. Athletes may not enter Beginner and Advanced in the same event. For those events in which the Intermediate level is optional (3-Baton, Artistic Twirl, Artistic Twirl Pairs and Duet), the athlete may enter both Beginner and Advanced if Intermediate is not offered as an event at that competition (IF the athlete is eligible to compete at the Beginner level in that event).

IMPORTANT INFO

- 1) AGE RULE: Athletes will compete at the age they will be on August 31, 2025.
- 2) **RESIDENCY RULES:** The State Championships events for AL, GA, and TN are open only to athletes residing in the respective state. Pairs/groups may enter only one State Championship (at least one athlete must reside in the state entered).
- 3) Any athlete may enter the Open Competition. The Open events are not awarded a state title.
- 4) **STATE CHAMPIONSHIP AGE DIVISIONS:** Primary: 0-9, Juvenile: 10-13, Junior: 14-17, Senior: 18-21, Adult: 22+.
 - If entries warrant, the State Championship events of Solo, Strut, Artistic Twirl, or Two Baton may be divided into the single age categories of 0-6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22+.
- 5) Age groups for the open competition will be determined by the entries for each event/level.
- 6) **State Grand Champions:** State Grand Championships will be presented for the State events of Men's Solo, Women's Solo, 2-Baton, 3-Baton, Artistic Twirl, and Strut. Juvenile athletes are age 10-13, Junior athletes are age 14-17, Senior athletes are age 18-21 and Adult athletes are age 22+.

ALABAMA STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

- AL State individual events: Medallions for 1st place, USTA medals 2nd through 7th places.
- AL State Grand Champions: AL State Grand Champions will receive a \$25 cash scholarship award and a Championship Cup. AL will award a Junior & Senior Grand Champion for Solo, Strut, Artistic Twirl, 2-Baton, & 3-Baton. The top 3 Juvenile & top 3 Junior athletes from the event preliminary will advance to the Junior Finals. The top 3 Senior & top 3 Adult athletes from the event preliminary will advance to the Senior Finals.
- AL State Group Events: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places medals for all team members.

GEORGIA STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

- GA State Individual Events: Medallions for 1st place, USTA medals 2nd through 7th places.
- GA State Grand Champions: GA State Grand Champions will receive a \$25 cash scholarship award and a Championship Cup. GA will award a Junior & Senior Grand Champion for Solo, Strut, Artistic Twirl, 2-Baton, & 3-Baton. The top 3 Juvenile & top 3 Junior athletes from the event preliminary will advance to the Junior Finals. The top 3 Senior & top 3 Adult athletes from the event preliminary will advance to the Senior Finals.
- GA State Group Events: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places medals for all team members.

TENNESSEE STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

- TN State Individual Events: Medallions for 1st place, USTA medals 2nd through 7th places.
- TN State Grand Champions: TN State Grand Champions will receive a \$25 cash scholarship award, medallion, and a revolving trophy. TN will award a Juvenile, Junior, Senior, and Adult Grand Champion for Solo, Strut, Artistic Twirl, 2-Baton, & 3-Baton. The top 3 athletes from the Juvenile, Junior, Senior, & Adult event preliminaries will advance to their respective finals.
- TN State Group Events: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places medals for all team members.

OPEN COMPETITION

- Open individual events: Trophies for 1st place, medals 2nd through 7th places.
- Open Group Events: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places medals for all team members.

Who is eligible for the All Around Champion contest?

Any athlete, regardless of residency or competition level, may enter the All Around competition.

Determining the winner:

The overall winner in each group will be determined using place points: 1st Place = 1 point, 2nd Place = 2 points, 3rd Place = 3 points, etc. For example, an athlete placing 1st in Solo (1 points), 4th in Strut (4 points), and 2nd in Two Baton (2 points) would have a total of 1+4+2=7 points. The athlete with the fewest place points in each division will be the All Around Champion. A tie in place points will be broken by combining total scores in all events.

Awards:

Awards will be presented to athletes finishing in the top 5. The overall winner of each group will receive an All Around Champion Sash and trophy.

RISING STAR

Age Groups* Levels Competes In These Events

0-6, 7-9, 10-13, 14+ Nov, Beg USTA Events: Basic, Presentation & Solo

Who is eligible for the Rising Star competition?

Any novice or beginner athlete, regardless of residency, may enter the Rising Star competition.

Determining the winner:

The overall winner in each group will be determined using place points: 1st Place = 1 point, 2nd Place = 2 points, 3rd Place = 3 points, etc. For example, an athlete placing 1st in Solo (1 points), 4th in Basic Strut (4 points), and 2nd in Presentation (2 points) would have a total of 1+4+2=7 points. The athlete with the fewest place points in each division will be the Rising Star Champion. A tie in place points will be broken by combining total scores in all events.

Awards:

Awards will be presented to athletes finishing in the top 5. The overall winner of each group will receive a Rising Star Champion Sash and trophy.

Other important information:

The events for the All Around Champion & Rising Star competitions are separate from all other individual events. So, an entry in the All Around or Rising Star competition enters an athlete in the events listed above, and ONLY athletes entered in the All Around or Rising Star competition will compete in each of those events. Athletes entered in the All Around or Rising Star competition may also choose to enter the same events in the AL, GA, or TN State (if eligible) and/or Open competition.

*The contest director reserves the right to combine or separate age groups as warranted by the entries

TRI-STATE HIGH SCHOOL CLASSIC

The high school twirling event is open to any individual, enrolled in high school or a member of their high school band. The athlete may use one or multiple batons (only standard batons can be used – no flags, knives, streamers, hoops, etc) to the school fight song and a musical selection of the athlete's choice. The high school twirling event should reflect the type of material utilized on the field by displaying musicality, movement across the field/competition floor, and presentation to the audience with the addition of one or multiple batons.

Awards:

The High School Champion will be awarded a Tri-State High School Champion sash and trophy.

TRI-STATE COLLEGE CLASSIC

The collegiate twirling event is open to any individual, enrolled in a college or university (undergraduate or graduate). The athlete may use one or multiple batons (only standard batons can be used – no flags, knives, streamers, hoops, etc) to the university fight song and a musical selection of the athlete's choice. The collegiate twirling event should reflect the type of material utilized on the field by displaying musicality, movement across the field/competition floor, and presentation to the audience with the addition of one or multiple batons.

Awards:

The College Champion will be awarded a Tri-State College Champion sash and trophy.

GROUP EVENTS INFORMATION

REMINDER OF IMPORTANT USTA TEAM/GROUP RULES (full event rules can be found in the USTA Rulebook):

- Team/group athletes' ages on August 31, 2025, will be used to determine age categories (either the average age or age of oldest team member may be used).
- Important Dance Twirl Team & Twirl Team rules:
 - o Dance Twirl Teams & Twirl Teams compete at the levels Novice, A, AA, AAA, and Elite.
 - Novice, A, and AA levels will be considered "open" or "Festival of the Future" level events. AAA and Elite levels will be considered "State," "Regional," or "National" level events.
 - o Each level (with the exception of Elite) has content restrictions.
 - See the USTA Rulebook for the full Dance Twirl Team & Twirl Team rules and content restrictions chart.
- Parade Corps, Entertainment Corps, Show Team, and Artistic Group rules:
 - o There is only one level for Parade Corps, Entertainment Corps, Show Teams, and Artistic Groups.
 - There are no age divisions for Parade Corps. Entertainment Corps have two age divisions: Primary/Juvenile (avg age 13.9 or younger) and Junior/Senior (avg age 14.0 or older).
 - o Show Teams have the following age divisions: Primary, Juvenile, Junior, and Senior.
 - Member requirement for Parade Corps, Entertainment Corps, and Artistic Group is a minimum of 10 members.
